# **Current and Upcoming Club Competitions**

- Tonight Print Vintage, Antiques, & Collectibles
- April 23 Digital due 4/9 Pick a Topic Front Porches
  - A covered or open area at the front of a house that's attached to the exterior and usually has a separate roof.
  - It is often used for relaxing, greeting guests, or enjoying the view.
  - Image must be taken between Feb 26<sup>th</sup> and April 9<sup>th</sup>.

# May 14 – Print – due 4/23 – Open – Square Dimension

- Image can be color, B&W, or monotone
- The image must have been taken within the last 24 months (May 2023 May 2025)
- The image must be sizd in a square (L=W) dimension
- All elements and layers of the image must meet the date criteria

# May 28 – Digital – due 5/14 – Rule of Odds

- The composition should have an odd number of items (e.g., 1, 3, 5, or 7)
- The Rule of Odds capitalizes on the brain's propensity for order. The brain wants to pair items, but odd numbers can't be paired. As such, the viewer's brain works harder, and the viewer looks at the image longer.
- Works better with seven or fewer objects.

### June 11 – Print – due 5/28 – Toys, Games or Sports

- Image features a toy, game, puzzle, sporting activity or the equipment (parts) used in any of these.
- The image may or may not include people.
- If the image includes spectators, participants or cheerleaders, the type or game or sporting event should be clear from the image.

### Creative Competition – Images due May 14; Awards May 28

- Images must be taken between March 26 and May 14, 2025
- Unlimited creative or artistic manipulation can be added to the image either in camera or during image processing
- Each member may submit up to two images
- Club members will vote for their favorite images between May 15 and May 28 at
- Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place (there will be no People's Choice since members are already doing the voting for the awards)

# **Tonight's Judge: Rob Coomer**

Rober Coomer is a professional fine ae photographer and brain injury survivor. Art has always been a big part of his life, earning him a Bachelor of Science in Graphic Design from the University of Cincinnati, College of Design, Art, Architecture and Planning. Whether chasing landscapes, wildlife, or aircraft, or the abandoned, Robert strives to capture a sense of place, to tell a story about his subject. His images are environmental portraits that lead the viewer to wonder about the subject's location, its history, and even its future. An overall theme of fading Americana comes through in his images, especially his urban exploration (urbex) and rural exploration (rurex) work. His steel series "Art in Decay", pushes his work into the mixed media category by combining his photography with hand-distressed and rusted steel to create "believable artifacts;"

A traumatic brain injury forced him to rethink and relearn much of what he thought he knew about his life and work. New beginnings and new struggles have made life tough, but they've also given him fresh insights. He's still figuring out what's next, but he's excited about the journey as he chases light and life.
